SHORT COURSE IN VIDEO EDITING

The Namibia Film Commission (NFC) hereby invites Namibian Filmmakers to apply for a short course in film and video editing (Avid and/or final cut). The course is designed to update the current editors with other software programmes and equip them with necessary skills of postproduction techniques with special focus on sound and visual effects.

The criteria to apply are:

- Applicants must be Namibians, 18 years or older, with a valid Namibian passport.
- Provide a motivation on why they want to attend the course and how they intend to utilize these new skills within the Namibian Film & Creative Industry.
- Submit samples of their previous work on DVD or link.
- Applicants must have at least 12 months working experience in an editing environment.
- Be an independent thinker, creative and flexible.
- Applicants must have no criminal record
- Be mentally fit and in good health.
- Applicants must be willing to attend the full course from 21st September – 9th October 2015 without interruption in Johannesburg, South Africa at the AFDA campus.

The training course is fully funded by the NFC. All applications should reach the NFC not later than Friday the 11th of September 2015.
